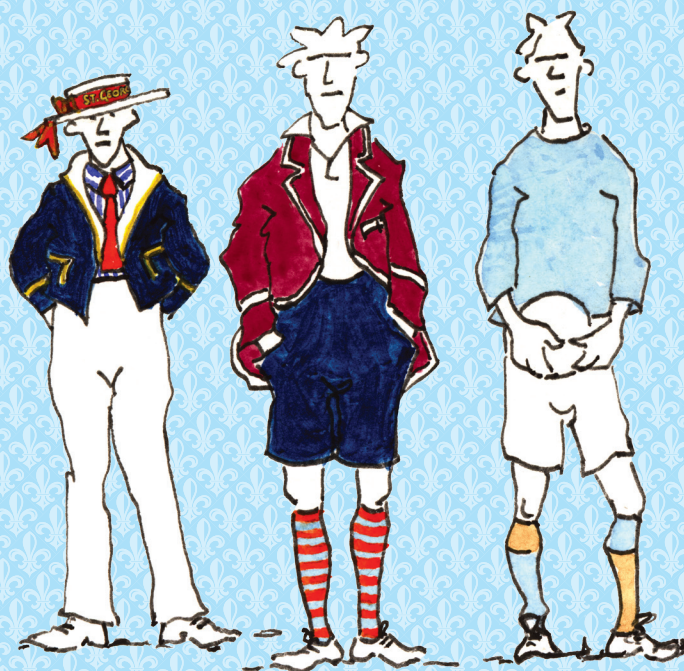


# ETON COLOURS
